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Counterfeit toys Quiz

Age	10-12 years old (advanced level)
Years	5th and 6th Year of Primary School

Objectives	 - Learn what counterfeit toys are. - Understand the hazards of counterfeit toys. - Know how to detect counterfeit toys.

Workshop developement	In order to revise and consolidate all the information presented in the infographics, the children can do a QUIZ. Either individually or in teams, they must answer a series of multiple choice and true or false questions using a tablet, smartphone or laptop. The question can be presented on the projector in class or on their screens, and there is a maximum time in which to answer. Once the quiz is over, a ranking will be made with the teams that have obtained the most correct answers.
